

2.1 Observations: Topics, Countries, Authors, Denominations

Topics:

- Theology and Culture (God, Relation to traditional religion)
- Applied Ethics (Environment, Peace, Violence, Business, Technology, Bioethics, Health, Gender, Minorities etc.)
- Interreligious challenges and experiences
- History and Structures: Colonialism, Church history, church and state, Reconstruction, three-self etc.

Countries:

- Selected countries with large contextual theological publications:
- · Asia: India, China, Indonesia, Philippines, South Korea, partly Japan
- Africa: South Africa, Kenya, Tansania, partly Ethiopia, RD Congo, Cameroun, others



2.2 Observations: Topics, Countries, Authors, Denominations

Authors and Period:

- Mainly male, but more and more also female
- Contextual: Mainly Christian Theologians, less Islam, Buddhism etc.
- Contextualisation mainly in decolonisation 1960-2000, new phases now

Denominations:

- Strong Protestant and Catholic contextualisation, less Orthodox.
- Pentecostals/ Charismatics growing last decades
- Interfaith growing. Relation to traditional religion less than in 20th century



3. The Political, Social, Economic, Historical Context of contextualisation: Colonialism, Post-colonialism, Re-Colonialism

The Context/ Perspective of

- Oppressors or oppressed
- Colonial, post-colonial or new colonial time period
- Majority religion or minority religion
- Ethnic minorities and majorities and their religion
- Nationalism, pluralism, secularism
- Political system: democracy, autocracy, dictorship, theocracy, anarchy
- Economic system: market economy, plan economy, mixed models




4. Contextualisation: Common and Different Hermeneutics

- In each religion, the divine becomes visible in the holy texts (revealed, revelation)
- Christian Contextualisation means Incarnation: God became a human in Jesus Christ (In-carnation means: «the Word became flesh»).
- The methology of interpretation and contextualisation of holy texts (=hermeneutics) differs greatly! 6 Methods accross religions, most clearly in Christianity:
- Critical-historical: understand holy texts from the context/language of their origins
- Fundamentalist: eternal word of the divine, context denied, but own context present
- Charismatic/Pentecostal: The Holy Spirit gives the right interpretation.
- Orthodox: main classical theologians are decisive for interpretation (e.g. church fathers)
- Mystical: the individual mystical experience with the Divine leads the interpretation
- Political: the political authorities define, which interpretation is politically correct or
